

## Requirements after registration

If you meet all our registration conditions, you will be registered in the quality register of the SCN. Registration is in personal capacity.

- If you have a foreign language background, you will work under the supervision of your practice supervisor until you have reached Dutch language level B1.

## General registration requirements

### Documents

If applicable, the annual delivery of:

- A copy of the professional liability insurance policy (if you do not participate in collective insurance through a professional association)
- A copy of the policy of affiliation with an independent complaints officer and dispute body (if you do not participate in collective insurance via a professional association)

### Inspection

An inspection system has been developed to test and guarantee the quality of care and to promote knowledge and skills. Every chiropractor registered with the SCN is required to adhere to this inspection. Inspection occurs on average once every five years, and per practice where you work.

### Re-registration

A registration period lasts five years. After these five years, the registration expires, and you must re-register. You are required to:

- Have met the set number of additional training hours per registration period (160)
- Have complied with the provision of at least eight hours of patient-related care per week

## Conditional registration can be converted to full registration, if:

- You have followed the mandatory refresher course on Dutch legislation as soon as possible, successfully completed it, and provided a certificate of participation.
- You have gained at least 1 year of practical experience at a chiropractic practice in the Netherlands/ you have worked at least 1 year as a chiropractor, under the supervision of a (SCN) chiropractor, with at least 3 years of work experience as a chiropractor in the Netherlands. This chiropractor is registered in a Dutch register for chiropractors.
- You have sent the Dutch B2 language certificate. If you have a foreign language background, make sure you have the Dutch B2 language certificate of the Common European Framework of Reference for the components of reading, writing, listening, and speaking that can be delivered within the set period. The certificate must show that you have passed all language components through testing. This certificate may not be older than two years.
